

## MISSION STATEMENT

Grandma's House is an intergenerational program at Orlando Health & Rehabilitation Center where adults and children live together in a home-like environment. This special neighborhood creates an extended family for children and adults with various disabilities.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Q.** Can the resident's family be involved in the child's care?
- A.** Yes. We encourage the involvement of families in the care of their children. The family plays an intricate role in the Grandma's House living experience.
- Q.** Can the staff accommodate a resident's food preferences?
- A.** Absolutely. Many of our residents require special diets because of health conditions. Our dieticians are qualified in providing nourishing and enjoyable food choices.
- Q.** Are there visiting hours?
- A.** The Orlando Health & Rehabilitation Center visiting hours are from 9:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m., however with prior notice, Grandma's House visitors are welcome any time. We ask that families understand and be sensitive to the residents' schedule for school, treatments, meals, nap times and, of course, bedtime.
- Q.** In what kind of activities do the residents participate?
- A.** We have a Pediatric Activities Director who organizes theme parties and holiday events, outings and special programs. Tuesday night is specifically designated as Intergenerational Night, however the adults may participate with the children in a variety of other unstructured activities during the week. Their purpose is to serve as mentors and "grandparents" to the children.



## MEDICAL SERVICES

A board-certified pediatric physician serves as the Medical Director. Grandma's House offers skilled nursing services to children who need all levels of care as determined by Children's Medical Services (CMS).

## NURSING SERVICES

- ♥ RN on Grandma's House unit 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- ♥ Registered Dietician specializes in pediatric nutrition needs
- ♥ Gastric tube feeding and TPN (Total Parenteral Nutrition)
- ♥ Intravenous monitoring (food and medicine)
- ♥ Central lines monitoring
- ♥ Wound care

## RESPIRATORY SERVICES

- ♥ Respiratory Therapist on site 7 days a week
- ♥ Tracheotomy Care
- ♥ Nebulizer treatments
- ♥ Apnea Monitoring
- ♥ Chest PT
- ♥ Continuous mists and oxygen therapy
- ♥ We do not have piped in oxygen
- ♥ Oxygen saturation monitoring
- ♥ Suctioning
- ♥ CPAP and BiPAP
- ♥ We do not have vents

## THERAPY SERVICES

- ♥ Each child is evaluated to develop a therapy treatment plan.
- ♥ A wheelchair positioning clinic is offered.
- ♥ A restorative nursing plan is established for each child as indicated.
- ♥ A splinting/bracing clinic is offered monthly.

## SPECIAL PROGRAMMING & ACTIVITIES

The Pediatric Activities Director provides a variety of programs, outings and special events daily. A medical escort provides transportation to appointments.

## EDUCATION/THERAPIES

Our Medical Director gives approval for children to either receive Hospital Homebound Education through Orange County Public Schools or to go off campus to attend a special needs school. Special needs schools offer a variety of therapies daily for the children.
